

## Statistics of International Trade

■ january to may of 2011 - Intra + Extra-EU Trade

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**NOTE**

In **June 2010**, Statistics Portugal announced a new data series on International Trade for the period 1993-2009. This new series resulted from a review process of its methodology, which reflected the need to obtain results with greater reliability and accuracy, and includes, in addition to various methodological changes, new information reported by companies.

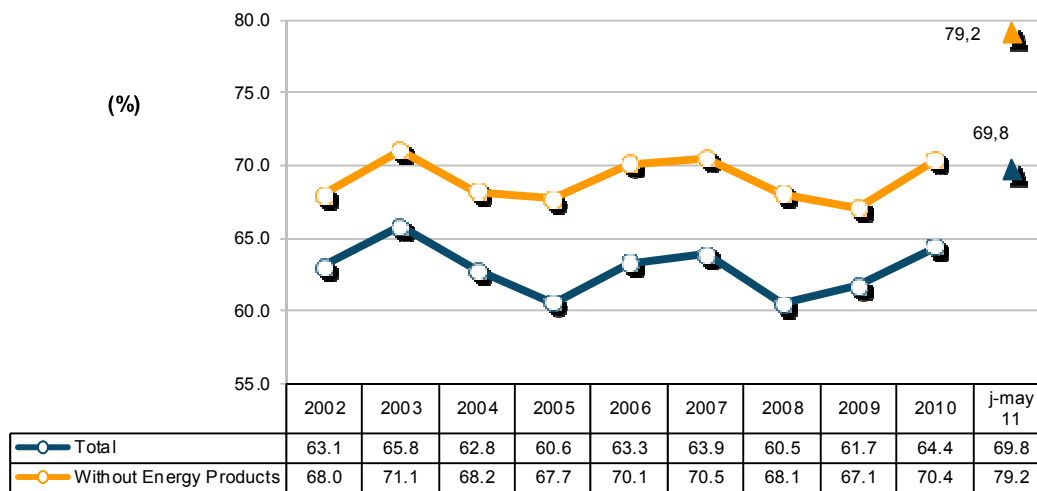
Since 1993, following the creation of the Single Market, the collection of information relating to international trade in goods is done by a new system supported by a compulsory survey (Intrastat declaration) for all operators, whose trade in goods with other Member States exceeds certain thresholds (assimilation threshold). Since 2005, and following the Community rules on quality control of the statistics on International Trade, a confrontation between regular information from the Intrastat system and data of an administrative nature was put in place, which included statements from Value Added Tax (VAT), as well as an analysis of the asymmetries with the statistics reported by other member countries. Following that, estimates for the total international trade, based on estimates for companies that are below the threshold of assimilation, as well as non-response of Intra-community trade started to be published.

The entry into force of “*Informação Empresarial Simplificada*” (IES) in 2007, contributed to ease the comparison of data on international trade with other sources, now made possible from 2006 onwards (reference period for the data). IES, along with information on the VAT constitutes an important source of information for the validity of the quality of the statistics on International Trade.

In **May 2011**, Statistics Portugal disseminated the definitive results concerning the year of 2009, in compliance with the Revision Policy of International trade, implemented in 2010. Also, the magnitude of an error detected on the data declared by an enterprise led Statistics Portugal to make an extraordinary revision on the data from 2007 and 2008 (Intra-EU Trade), which is reflected in this publication.

<sup>1</sup> Database of international trade (Intra and Extra EU) released by Statistics Portugal (SP) for the period of January to May of 2011, corresponding to preliminary versions for both intra and extra community trade. The data for intratrade includes estimates for non-responses (value of transactions of companies for which SP has not yet received information), as well as periodic reporting of companies that are below the assimilation threshold (annual value of intra-Community below which operators are exempted from Intrastat statistical declaration, limited to delivery of the periodic tax declaration: in the case of Portugal, 200 thousand euros for imports from EU and 250 thousand for exports to EU in 2011). On the other hand, the current methodology considers, in addition to the regular comparison between the Intrastat declarations and Value Added Tax (VAT), the comparison with the data obtained from “*Informação Empresarial Simplificada*” (IES).

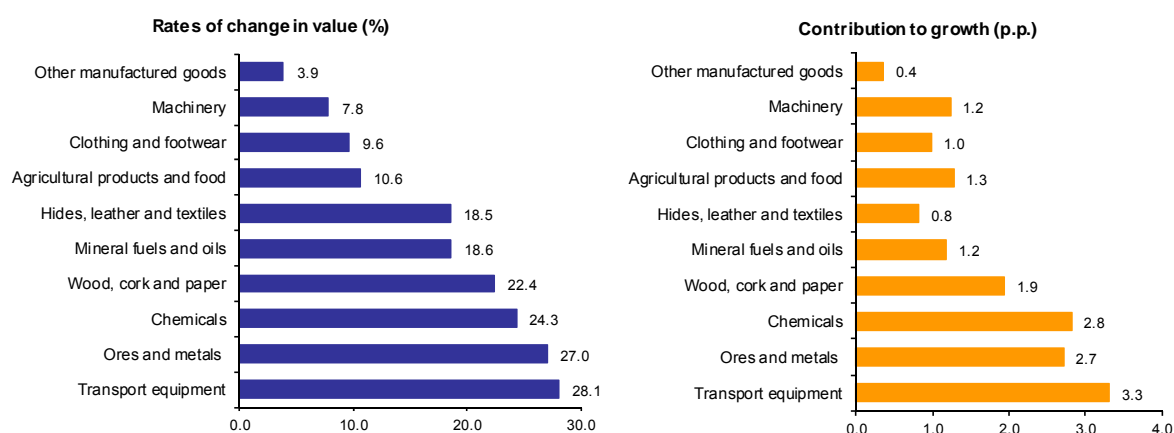

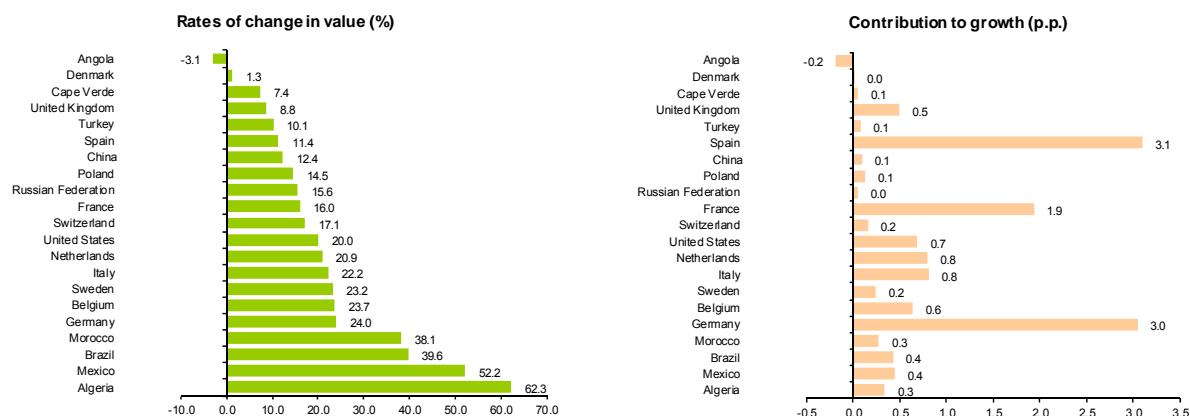

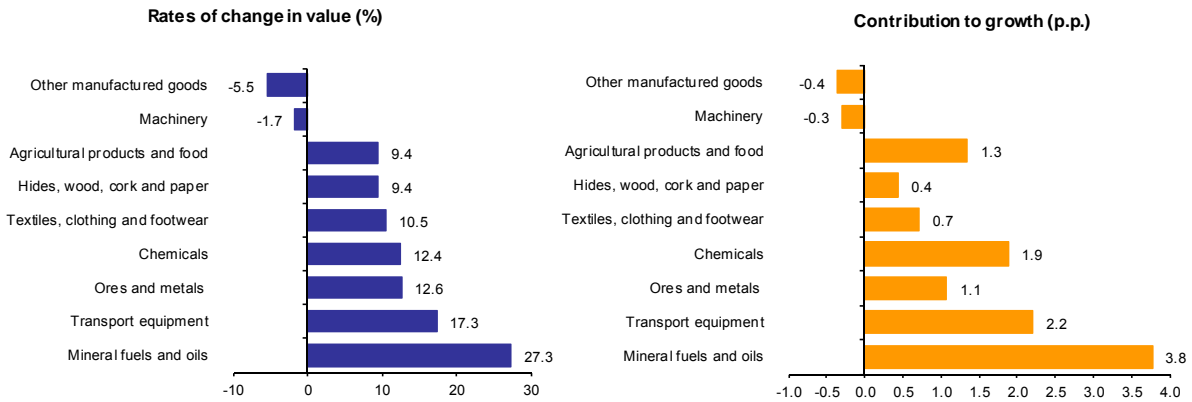

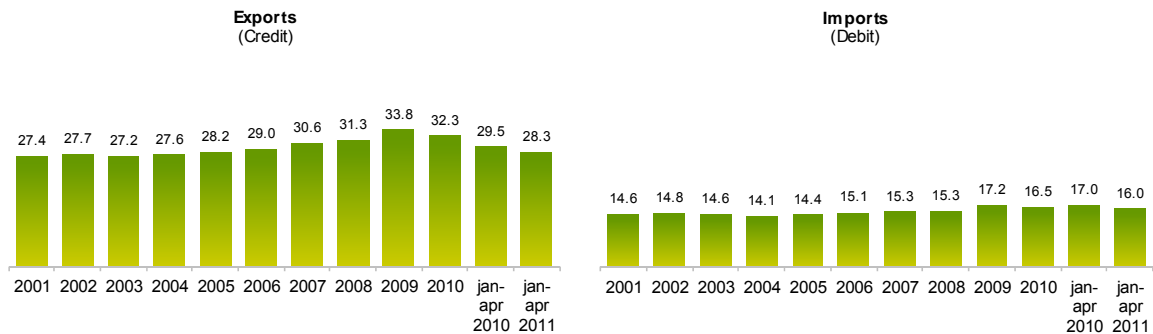

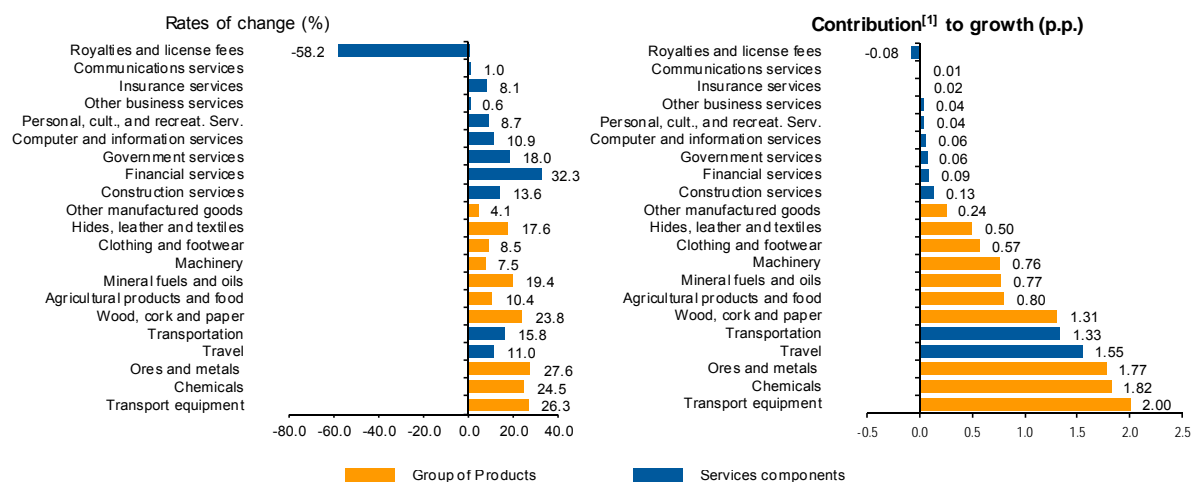
